Throughout history, coastal areas and maritime spaces have been an important pole of attraction for civilization insomuch as nowadays they are central to well-being and prosperity of European Regions. Human activities in coastal zones and marine areas (industry, tourism, agriculture, fishing, aquiculture, energy production, transport...) tend to develop together, thus coming into conflict with each other and with protection needs of natural habitats and landscapes. The awareness-raising has produced specific measures and regulations, but an integrated approach is needed to assure the sustainable development of these areas. The European Commission is conscious of the enormous economic and ecologic importance of coasts and seas, as the ICZM Recommendation, the Blue Book on Maritime Policy and the Marine Strategy demonstrate. Anyway more efforts are necessary at every level and the Regions could play a strategic role in the development of integrated strategies and coordinated policies, also through the interregional cooperation.

Over a period of two years, the INTERREG IIIB CADSES **PlanCoast** project with 16 partners in 12 countries throughout the Baltic, Adriatic and Black Sea Regions has focussed on **Maritime Spatial Planning** (MSP) and **Integrated Coastal Zone Management** (ICZM). The challenge was to show the strength of spatial planning instruments to the benefit of an effective ICZM and maritime policy in a number of pilot projects. The results of the pilot projects have been summarized in the **PlanCoast Handbook**.

The aim of the Conference is to share the PlanCoast experience and results with a wider range of stakeholders, in order to strengthen ICZM and MSP implementation and to continue the scientific debate on specific issues.
